From NJ Turnpike exit 7A: Take I-195 East to Route 526. Make a Right on Route 526 to Main Street. Make a Right on Main St. to Route 539. Make a Left on Route 539 to Arneytown-Hornerstown Road. Make a Right on Arneytown-Hornerstown Road. From NJ Turnpike exit 7: Take Route 206 North to Route 528 (Crosswicks Road). Make a Right on Route 528; travel approximately 6 miles, Pass through 1 roundabout. and stay straight DO NOT TURN RIGHT. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, A or B division.
